Ripe cherry, currant, juniper, cafe cream, almond, cinnamon, light smoky note; Powerful, dense and full-bodied; rich, ripe tannins with a slight toasty note that recedes with maturity. Fruit and wood are beautifully interwoven. Good storage potential. Depth and power. It is rightly called Titan!
